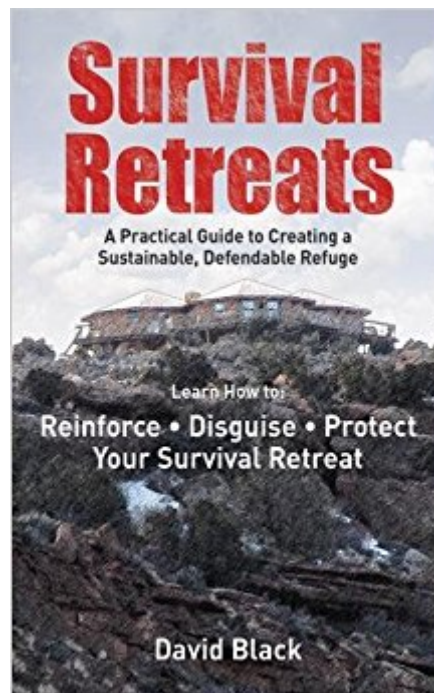

This book was my first in the genre of survival during a doomsday scenario. It was not heavily detailed, but it hit the main points and didn't take a week to read. It seemed like an excellent primer, pointing out things I would never have thought of on my own, and also described simple solutions to many of the vulnerabilities my household has. The author also points out many resources throughout the book for people to access when they want to go deeper than the primer material will take them. Since I didn't want to jump in the deep end when I bought it, this book hit a home run. I wanted a short, easy read that touched the main points but didn't get bogged down in too much detail. Since it gave me resources to find what I need when I want to swim into the deep end, this book hit a grand slam home run. I will reference it's resources as I make changes around the home.
