

As many times as I've read Luke's Gospel, I've never really paid attention to one verse (22:31): "Simon, Simon, behold, Satan has demanded permission to sift you like wheat; but I have prayed for you, that your faith may not fail; and you, when once you have turned again, strengthen your brothers." I know God allowed Satan to attack Job to prove that Job would remain faithful, but I didn't remember that God allowed Satan to "sift" Simon Peter. And Jesus' response wasn't to tell the devil "no" or make it easy for Peter, he prayed that Peter's faith wouldn't fail. Although the pop culture references (celebrity quotes, song lyrics, etc.) didn't resonate with me and I didn't agree with everything he said, the author's discussion of how God sifts each of us made a big impact on me.

This is the first book I have ever read by this author, but I can assure you it won't be the last. Everyone has been sifted many times during the course of their lifetime. I certainly have. Now I have a deeper perspective and insight that because of my sifting, I am able to walk more intimately with my Lord. He has allowed me to be sifted to equip me to walk with others during their sifting. I especially liked the author's chapter on the meaning of names. I compose and speak Blessings for people and always include the origin and meaning of their names. Names are indeed powerful and parents should consider that when they are giving names to their newborns. Thank you, Rick Lawrence for a very moving book. It has changed the way I think about God allowing bad things to happen to good people. It's all for the glory of Christ.

Rick Lawrence delves into the murky waters of sifting seasons to interpret this violent, lonely soul stripping process of being prepared for promotion in the kingdom. The Bible is riddled with accounts of men and women who are plunged into the pits of despair prior to stepping onto platforms of purpose. If you are not in the season of sifting now you may be soon and this book is an excellent companion and guide for navigating through the pain and the promise.
