

I've been drawing for over 20 years with recently having an interest in drawing buildings and structures. I purchased this book thinking it would get me started on doing so, and I was excited when it arrived. It did get me started; however, I'm not thrilled about the instructions. I do like that it doesn't have worded instructions, but as one reviewer mentioned, it jumps from simplicity to complexity in a matter of four "steps." Not to mention, when it comes to the "final" step, it's completely finished! Where did those extra lines come from? Sometimes it's difficult to make out the lines or dots in the finished products because they're so close together. If I didn't have drawing experience, this would be extremely challenging. I don't know how this is appropriate for an 8 year old but people develop at their own pace.

It's a great very very beginners book to help how to draw different buildings from simple structure of lines. A great one to have around, like those with animals.
