

There something wonderful about past editions. Small changes between texts. Often the chapters and content will remain the same with only minor changes to the examples given in the book. The book that I would have purchased at the bookstore would likely have been \$100+, but I purchased this from for a mere \$11. That impresses me. What impresses me more is the Research Methods lecture doesn't deviate from the 7th edition text. I saved upwards of \$85 and get the exact same result as other students. If this is a new concept to some of you college students take advantage of your new knowledge. However, I have to caution you: some classes require the new text because of the constant change within the field. Remember that. What's true in Speech-Language Pathology this year may be altered next year.
