

She has to be one of the cutest children's book characters I've ever seen. The illustrator, An-Lon Chen, uses vibrant colors to create charming characters and little critters that add to the playfulness of the story. The lighthearted rhyme will delight young children, all the while reminding readers that it just takes one person to care enough to help change a situation for the better. I highly recommend picking up a copy of Carmin Cares.

Early on in grade school, I remember telling my dad that I was very disappointed that our grade school didn't have a school store like my sister's junior high.
