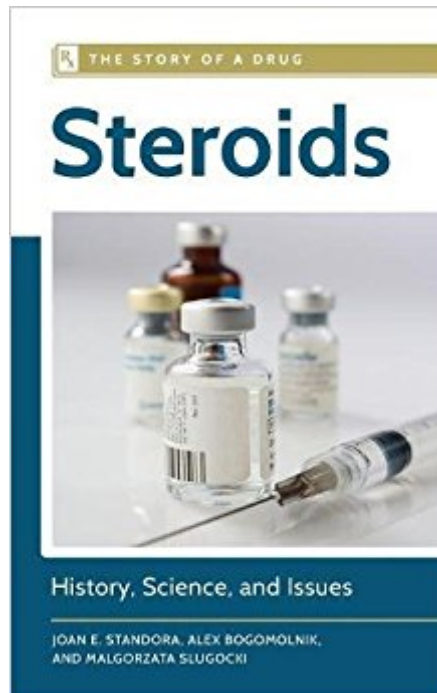




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Steroids: History, Science, And Issues (The Story Of A Drug)
