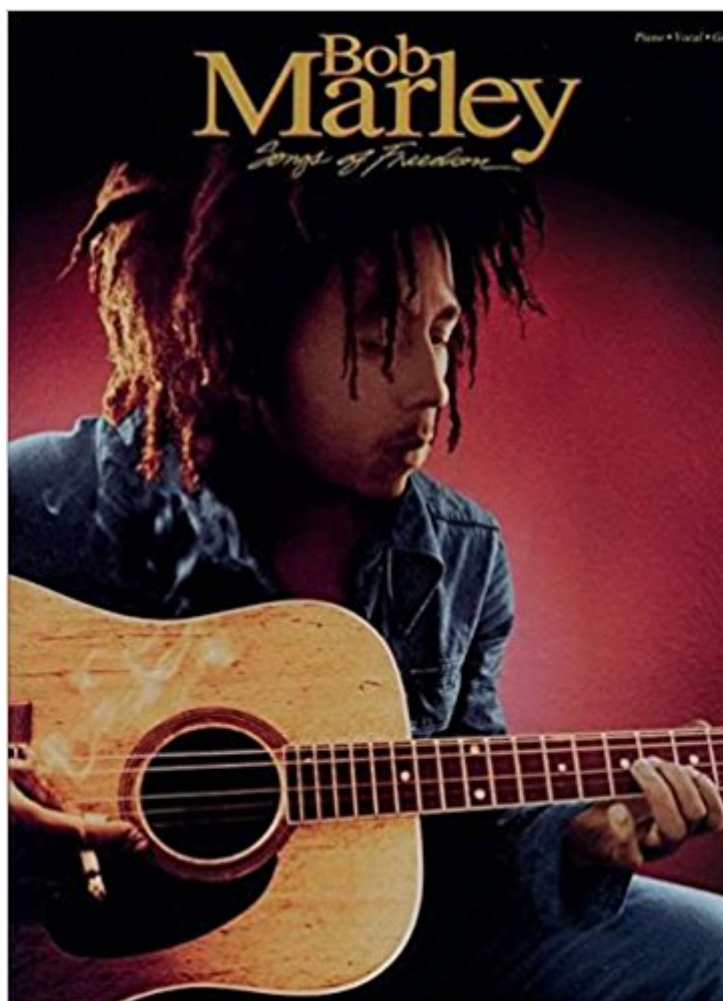

This is in a coffee-style format to take advantage of lots of great photos but it is much more than a coffee-table book. It is put together by noted, competent figures in reggae journalism (Boot and Salewicz, and "Executive Editor" Rita Marley) and qualifies as a legitimate biographical account of the life of Bob Marley. No, not a definitive biography - that doesn't exist - but it is filled with interesting material from start to finish. It is a welcome addition to the field, much different in style, tone and substance than Tim White's *Catch A Fire* and in some ways more accessible, or I should say, makes Bob more accessible. Compared to another coffee-style book, Lee Jaffe's *One Love*, the photos are about equally good (both constitute outstanding photographic portfolios of Bob and the people and places around him) but the text is far more satisfying.
