

Loved this series. Ruby, Pearl, Opal, and Amethyst we're all great stories and each one adding characters as the story went along made it a great read.

Amethyst is my kind of person; she is not afraid of hard work, she is creative, she doesn't let difficult circumstances get her down, and she isn't afraid to go after what she wants. During all of this, her faith grows with only little occasional dips. Amethyst is sent out west to retrieve her nephew (or is he?) so he can inherit the family property which has only survived because of her hard work due to

her father's drinking. She falls seriously ill along the way and is befriended by an older lady she has met on her train ride to the Dakotah Territory. She finally arrives in Little "Misery" when it is indeed being miserable -a blizzard and almost dies again while trying to reach a boarding house run by Pearl and Carl from previous Treasure stories. She finds her nephew,becomes good friends with Pearl, and meets a certain dashing Major who has just retired from the Army to return to his favorite place and friends to settle down permanently.Amethyst is offered a business opportunity which would take her to Chicago, away from her new friends, her nephew, and the very nice Major. Where will she end up? Will she have to choose? What has God planned?

I got this the first book in this series for free on my Kindle and read it because I needed a light fiction book, something mindless. By the end of the book I was hooked on the story and had to buy the rest of the books in the series to find out what happens to the characters and story! I did not expect to get hooked because the book seemed childish in its setup and story, but I came to LOVE the story and the characters, and actually cared about what happened to them.
