

In these 3 volumes, Jamaal Zarabozo examines each of an-Nawawi's 40 hadith in-depth. For each one he provides the Arabic text, his own translation, a selected vocabulary list, analysis of the hadith's authenticity, detailed commentary on each sentence of the hadith, and reflections on the topics covered by the hadith. In doing so, he covers a huge variety of issues, and provides a wealth of information for the reader. The analysis Zarabozo does is often influenced by his anti-madhabism, puritanism, and deep respect for scholars like al-Albani. Yet despite his intellectual leanings, the work

is free from most "Salafi" rhetoric, and sticks closely to issues that are relevant for all Muslims regardless of their "methodology". Zarabozo is most concerned with giving Muslims a deep understanding of these extremely important hadith, and I would definitely recommend this book to any serious student of Islamic knowledge.

These forty hadith were chosen by Imam An-Nawawi for their coverage of the religion. Jamaal Zarabozo has done a fine job of expounding on these hadith to bring out their fruits. He collects the opinions of classical as well as contemporary scholars to give a comprehensive understanding of Islam. You will find in the book aspects of the Islamic Belief, Islamic Jurisprudence, Prophetic Sayings, Explanation of the Noble Quran and other Islamic subjects. Good to read on your own but even better to study with a teacher and great for Islamic Studies.

I purchased the three volume set and was disappointed when I received a two volume set. The price for the two volume set was forty dollars cheaper than the three. I could've saved the money and bought the same two volume set. Now I have to pay to return the books. I don't believe the seller is to be trusted.
