

Dense with both philosophical analysis and major religious issues, this is by no means fictional "page turner," but well worth the effort; the book's structure, featuring short quotes and essay by many leading modern spiritual rabbis makes it easy to take the book in small doses for those, like me, who may need time to digest the "big picture" life questions which may be addressed through prayer.
