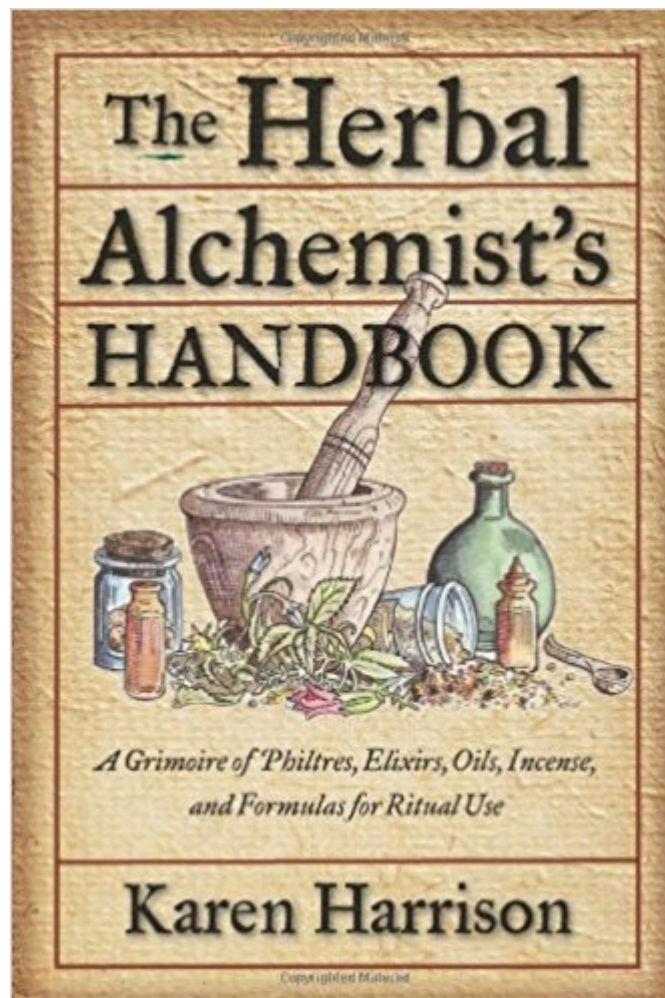

I really wanted to like this book, but after wading in several times, I just can't get there. If you are interested in alchemy, there are many better introductions. Look for books about spagyrics. If you are interested in herbalism, the same. This one has some super basic stuff about incense too, but is less helpful than many websites out there. The book really glosses over some basic ideas and has a lot of language about manifesting. It is certainly not a handbook. That implies that it would be a useful reference, which it is not. Sorry.

I am very upset with the author of this book, because the title and description are extremely misleading. This is not a book that explains alchemy! It is a new age astrology association book. In no shape or form does this book explain anything about the practices of alchemy, nor does it have instructions or recipes. For example her recipe for bath tea bags is to put herbs and salt in a muslin bag! Not to mention that particular page is repeated twice in the book, very poor editing. If you want

to know which planet and astrology sign associates with what herb (???), then this is the book for you. If you're looking for a book explaining alchemy with instructions and recipes to make herbal elixirs, tinctures, etc, then definitely look elsewhere. Even the herbal directory in this book is measly and disappointing. Also, I have been using essential oils for over a decade and the section in this book regarding essential oils is not only very vague, the information that is there, is incorrect! It is very clear that the author has no knowledge of essential oils. I can't find one good thing about this book. I don't know how anyone can give this book 5 stars, they must have really wanted to know which herbs are associated with which planet or astrology sign!

A great intro to making some wonderful magickal mixtures. It gives the basic premise of formulating and creating the mixtures. I suppose I was hoping for more details on the alchemy and maybe more personal recipes (because Karen's blends are to die for), but that was my own expectation and is no reflection on the author.
