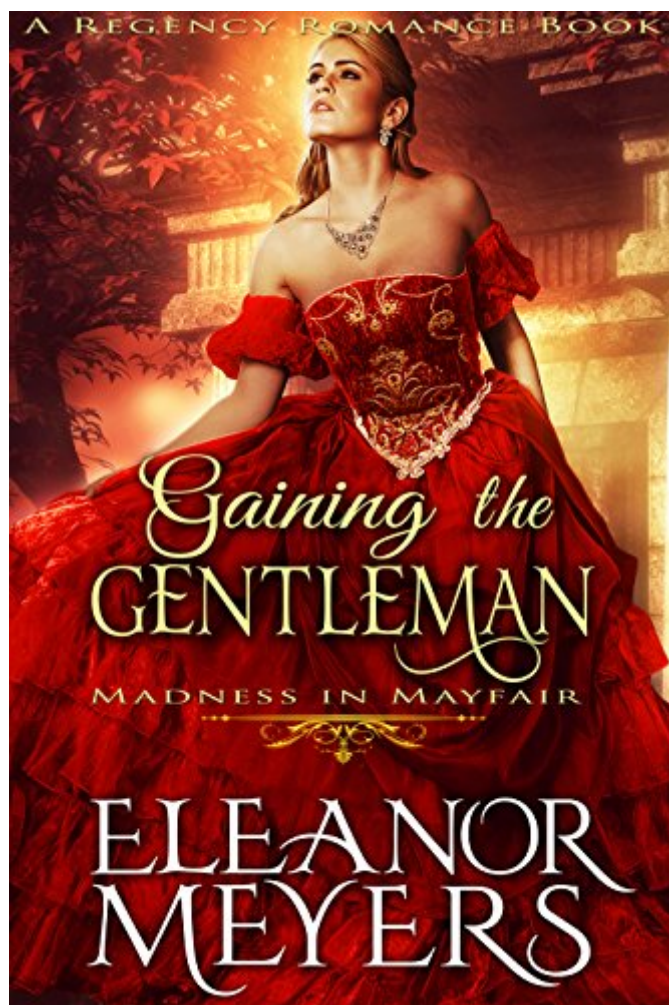


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Gaining The Gentleman (Madness In Mayfair) (A Regency Romance Book)

Full disclosure: I received this book as an ARC. This wonderful series continues. Many of the members of the families of Wardington Park have found their soul mates, however Joseph Croftman and Christa Eaton are still searching. Joseph is a very prosperous landed gentry and heir of Angelbook Manor. Christa is the daughter of the late Duke of Hensman and has lived her entire life watching the evil effects of a marriage without love. Her loveless relationship with her father made Christa a bitter young woman with few friends. Upon his death, Christa takes an extended trip to the continent to just get away. The marriage of her cousin Amy Ott to Nate Dawnton has brought a sense of calm and friendship that Christa has never known. Could Amy's influence and the time in France have softened Christa? June, a somewhat friend from her childhood, appears with an offer to become involved in a secret scavenger hunt for a lost jeweled necklace. Joseph insists he accompany the ladies in this crazy scheme and begins to see the new Christa. The scavenger hunt has lots of twists and turns with clues that lead to abandoned homes, paramours, and a Spanish villain. As I have enjoyed the Wardington Park series, I have frequently become confused about just who belongs to which family. Ms Meyers has given us a treat in this book. While this book is about Christa and Joseph, we also get to check in on Martin and Abigail, Priscilla and Levi, Mark and others in this group who now feel like old friends. I thoroughly enjoyed following Joseph and Christa's developing courtship, as well as catching up with various family members and friends. Very highly recommended book and series.

I must say it took me a bit of reading to get familiar with the various family members in this story, Thank goodness the author has included a reference for the different characters in this book. Having said that, I have to say, I LOVED this well written, well developed, sometimes very serious, sometimes humorous and all the time really carries you along story.
