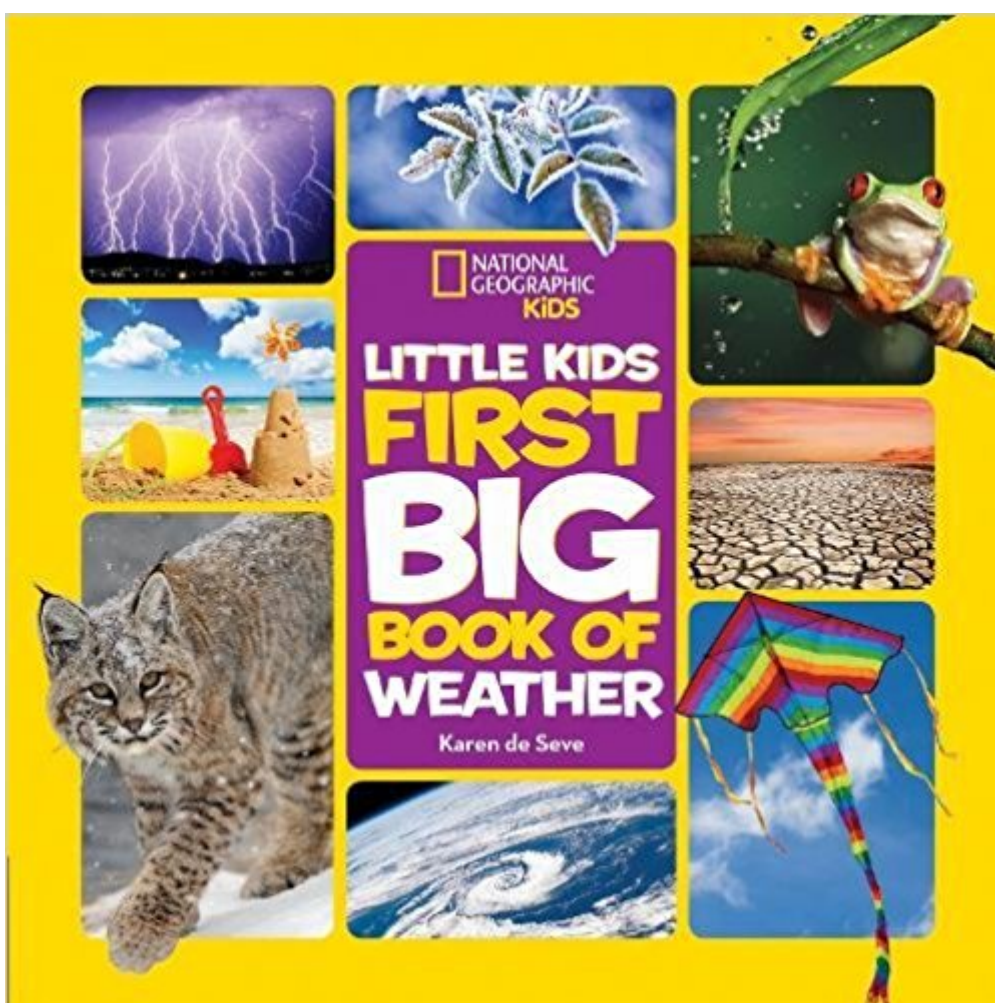

We bought the Space book from this series first: "National Geographic Kids First Big Book of Space (National Geographic Little Kids First Big Books)" and our daughter really enjoyed it and learned a lot from it. So when she expressed an interest in weather we ordered this one. It seems good, too, if a little short on details; it seems to be a little less in depth than the Space book. But otherwise, it is attractive, well organized and engaging for our 3.5 year old. My main concern about this book is a glaring error on page 18 (photo attached). There is a photo of a polar bear on an ice sheet and the photo caption reads: "Antarctica is the coldest place on Earth." Wow. I think it's fairly common knowledge that there are no polar bears on the continent of Antarctica. So I'm a little concerned about buying any more books in this series. If the publisher can allow an error like this through, what else might be wrong?

This book was both informative and fun. The information was simply put, but able to provide enough info for an adult to enjoy learning as they read it to a child. The designs in the book were well placed and certainly added to the overall experience. I can see myself using this book in the future with my students. The only problem I have with this National Geographic series is the use of the term "Little Kids" in the title. It's a small issue but I can see plenty of students complaining about being described as a little kid. This book could certainly be used in a middle grade classroom, so it sets itself up to be an issue. Overall, this was an enjoyable and interesting book. I would highly recommend it.*I received this book for free from the publisher in exchange for an honest review.
