

While the scope was adequate, I felt the depth was lacking. Overall, it was still an enjoyable read but each sub-section left me wanting more information about the person. The most disturbing aspect of the book was the lack of pictures. For sure, pictures were included but for many subjects, I had to do a Google image search. How hard would it have been to insert a picture for each person listed in the book? When the topic is "human oddities" a picture is needed in order to get a real feel of the person's challenges. Interesting subject matter, though the author's treatment of it tends to be brief and her writing skills are nothing special. The most annoying thing about this book is that she occasionally goes on rants about "political correctness." Therefore, it should not come as a surprise that she is not physically abnormal, nor does she seem to know anyone who is, and yet she believes that she (not the freaks themselves) has the sole right to determine how human oddities should be viewed and treated. She calls anyone who opposed freak shows "do-gooders" (sarcasm explicitly intended). Oh no, being worried about the exploitation of vulnerable people for financial gain is so malevolent! The one-sided cases of this throughout the book could only be called naive and condescending, not the callous acts of self-righteous SJWs. Their problem is that they didn't ask what the freaks themselves thought or wanted, which, of course, the author fails to do either. Good book, would be a better one if not for the inclusion of the author's biases.
