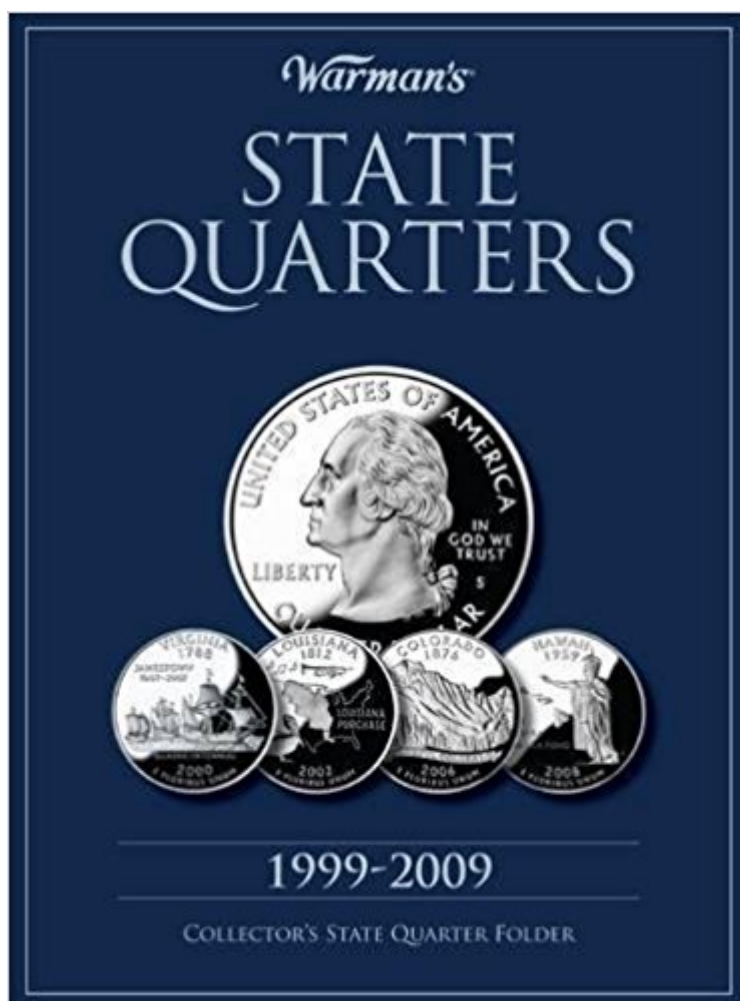

Very good. Those who think it ends by 2006 needs to pull blue paper out, which is on the third page.

I purchased this product for my 6 year old son who had started collecting state quarters on his own. He was thrilled to get this and spent all day yesterday filling it with his collection. It also comes with two extra spaces for quarters on the last page. I'm not sure what the original purpose of those spots were but he filled them with an eagle quarter and drummer boy quarter and was trilled that he could add those quarters to his collection. The only negative, and it's barely worth mentioning is that the font is, as my son put it, "fancy" and for a 6 year old it took him a bit to get the hang of reading the states in that font.

Great book for collecting the state quarters. It has one slot for each state. I like this book because it has all the years in one book and it doesn't specify which mint. Other books I have specify the mint and some I just can't find so it frustrates me to have the empty slots. These you need just one of each, which are great for gift giving a full set. I got 4 for each of my friend's grandkids.

I received a replacement folder as the first folder had a flaw in it, the 2nd page out of the 3 pages was not there instead there were 2x page #3. But when I did receive the replacement folder today, I try to put in my quarters that I already owned, including a couple of Proof versions of the quarters. I noticed that the proof versions of the quarters required a lot more force in order for them to be put in place. Just be aware to any potential buyers that this folder was made for the circulated versions of the quarters. As the rims of the circulated versions are worn off more than the proof versions, and this folder takes into account the wearing of the edges.

I bought this for my granddaughter, she is 11 and she loved it. She immediately went through all of our change looking for the quarters to start to fill up her book. She will have fun searching for quarters everywhere she goes. What a fun family gift, they will all help her. I am thinking of getting her another book or two for Christmas.

It works perfectly for your state quarter collection. I had been using an 'old' folder for my state quarters. It was a folder meant to be used for quarter's from the 1900's (yeah, not that long ago) but the new quarters didn't fit in it. Who knew that quarter size had changed that much? Now, I just need to find Puerto Rico

It's fun to bring home your pocket change and fill these up with kids. This works well to store my step sons quarter collection so far. Fits easily in his small floor safe. Be sure to read the description and make sure you are getting the correct one for your collection. May order the other folders as well.

The quarter holders are easy to put in but hard to take out so make sure you put them in the way you want them other than that I love it
