

Bryan O'Malley's run pokes fun at the banalities of life while making you feel like a twenty something kid again. The art is charming and original (even if you read Japanese comics). The diverse cast of characters are unique archetypes that keep you hoping they will come back in every panel. May slightly confuse those unfamiliar with videogame pop-culture, but not enough to distract one from the story. My wife especially loved the interlude short stories. Scott Pilgrim will leave you wishing for more once you've completed this six volume series.

I pre-ordered this a long time ago, So long in fact that it was a surprise when I checked my mail to find it sitting there. I was a HUGE fan of the movie, and I wanted more of Scott in my life. So I tried reading the comics. Somehow I was not able to get into the black and white ones. The art style was just not aesthetically pleasing enough to entice me for the duration of the book. This lead me to pick up the colored version. And it was not a mistake, all of the coloring is beautifully done, and at this

point I wouldn't take the art any other way. The story in the comic differs from the story in the movie, so it doesn't feel like I'm reading something I already know. It gives a much more in-depth look into the characters lives. The binding and the hard cover feel expensive and very durable. Onipress did a fantastic job securing Scott Pilgrim a place on my book shelf for years to come. The third book does not disappoint. If you are bored and need a good read that will not make you feel stupid and roll your eyes like most comics and manga today. Go pick up a copy of these books!

Maybe I need to look more closely at Scott's hair? I like the way the movie handled Vegan Todd (it was much less deus ex machina, although the comic is very meta in its handling of it). I find the meta-ness a little unwanted at times, but it's still fun so far...

This book was really fun after this first 2 books I thought it would have gone stale but book 3 is still really fun. The colors and art and dialogue are all great, especially if you're a band geek.

I am a huge Scott Pilgrim so maybe it's just a little bias when I say these hardcover color editions are awesome. Now I know there's something people who feel it takes away from the originals but I don't agree with that sentiment at all if anything it breathes new life into it and makes almost as much fun as reading through them the first time so for first time readers you are in for a genuine treat. For people on the fence who own the original set like me these look great on the shelf and are a blast to read through and see all that was once old be kinda new again. For people who only watched the movie or played the game this is Scott Pilgrim in its greatest form please check these out you're missing out on so much that the movie just couldn't cram in.

Great continuation to a marvelous tale, yet this book felt rather rushed, and begins to draw the line between departure from the film's story and starts adding subplots. Worth the read, yet it's definitely not my favorite of the bunch.

Since this is a 2006(?) book I won't talk much about the writing. All I'll say is this, this is not a

commic for everyone. It makes a lot of references to old videogames, underground music, comics and mangas. Because of that i would not recommend this to a comic novice and/or someone who does not appreciate the nice little references. About the edition itself: just awesome! Scott deserves a good quality edition like this, the comic is that good. The coloring is very well done and it fits the comics so well. The hardcover is very sturdy and i just love the extras. I see no downsides for this edition, a prime quality comic now in prime quality material. Must buy.
