

First time abroad with an eight year old in tow, this book was a vacation saver. It kept her engaged in all the major sights while (I'm hoping) teaching her a little about parisian history. I would absolutely recommend this book to anyone with young travelers. I would say it's probably appropriate for not much younger than 7 or 8, unless you have a very advanced child on your hands. Also, be sure to read the scavenger list before visiting the site, as some of what your looking for is a little esoteric.

Kids loved it! They had tons of fun looking for things when we were in Europe and I do think that it made the trip much more fun for them, except some of the things were incredibly hard to find and my kids are a bit stubborn and would not leave until they found all the items !

This book was essential for our successful family vacation to Paris. We brought along three "kids travel books" on our trip, and this one was the clear winner. It's written in a style that our kids preferred (speaking directly to the kids as secret agents, and not in a childish/patronizing tone), is clear enough for the kids to comprehend, and has a professional layout and pictures (not hand-drawn or cartoonish). It kept our five- and eight-year-old sons motivated to visit the city's main attractions, helped us bond as a family when we accomplished each assignment, and was not at all complicated, leaving mom and dad sane to enjoy the cultural institutions (because we're on

vacation, too). My husband and I loved traveling the world before we had kids, and before we found this book, the kids were not as enthusiastic about being dragged around to unfamiliar places. This book has made it possible for us to keep up that passion. We will be buying the rest of the books in the collection and filling up our passports!

I am going to Paris with my grand children and I hope they will enjoy looking for the clues of the adventure. They seem to be interesting but I will be able to value it on the field. It's a pity it does not include Versailles being so close and that I think a visit to Paris with children without going there is a mortal sin.

We bought this book for our granddaughter who we took to Paris. It was so much fun for her. She was so busy checking things off and collecting points. It only that, there is quite a bit of historical information that she read before we left. I have recommended this book to many people!

We got one copy for our 7 and 9 year old girls to take on a trip to Paris. They absolutely loved going through this book and marking off things as we saw them throughout the city. The first thing they did each night was to count up how many points they got each day. We are already planning on getting the one that is available for our trip to Italy this summer. I hope that the author comes out with more cities!

My 10 year old had such a good time working her way through this book! She was excited to visit the different missions and took her book everywhere, reading about Paris and crossing off the things she saw and did. We had such a blast completing the missions! I really like that admissions aren't required to do these missions and even though we made our travel itinerary before we had the book, we were able to fit in all these missions in addition to our other plans. Everyone in the family enjoyed it!

I love these books! My kids are 12, 14 and 16 so I was afraid they might think they were "baby" books but they are enjoying them. I just wish there were books for London and Berlin.
