

I have to be totally honest and say that like some readers of this book I had never heard of the web-series it is based on---and you know what: for me as someone who enjoys books more than movies that is probably a good thing. With that said, however, what Paige McKenzie has constructed with the character Sunshine is great on so many levels, and I'll share some of the highlights of the book from my perspective here. First thing that I love is the realness of Sunshine. She is not a perfect young girl who is having to deal with injustices heaped upon her. The way the book is written you are able to experience her feelings, her fears and the evolution of her

strength. We are able to see what a move to a new place does to her as well as the way she responds to the darkness that seems to be trying to envelop her mother and her. Through the book we are also able to see that thanks to Nolan, Sunshine doesn't have to try to figure out things for herself. He is there to help, but are they really prepared for what is to come? I would have to say the great thing about this book is that it shows what someone who truly loves another is willing to do in order to save them---regardless of the danger to themselves. That, to me, is one of the greatest things about the way Sunshine Griffith is brought to life on the page. She truly loves the woman she calls mom, and that love takes her down a road that she can't soon escape. **THE HAUNTING OF SUNSHINE GIRL** is a fast-paced read that will make you want to see what else Paige McKenzie might have up her sleeves. Since reading the book I have not gone to the web-series (as I am sure others will as well), just to get an idea of what is next. Definitely a book that is great for readers of all ages to enjoy, this is one that is sure to be considered one of the highlights of 2015 for me.
