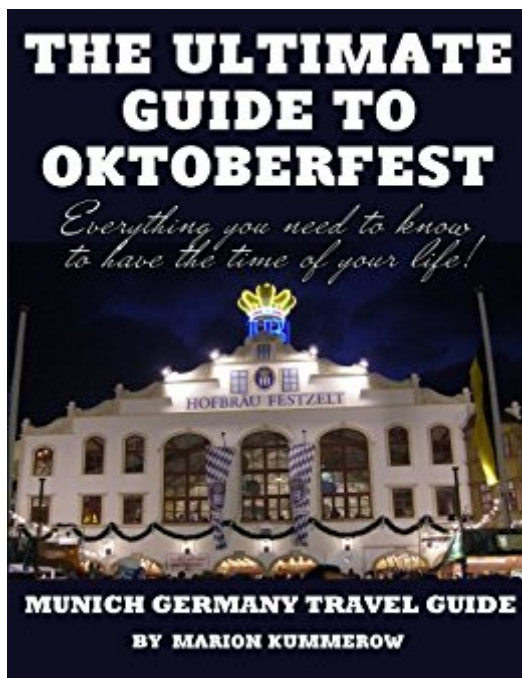

I learned that the Oktoberfest is so much more than a big beer festival with large tents and drunken people and it would be a real waste of time when going there without thorough preparation.
