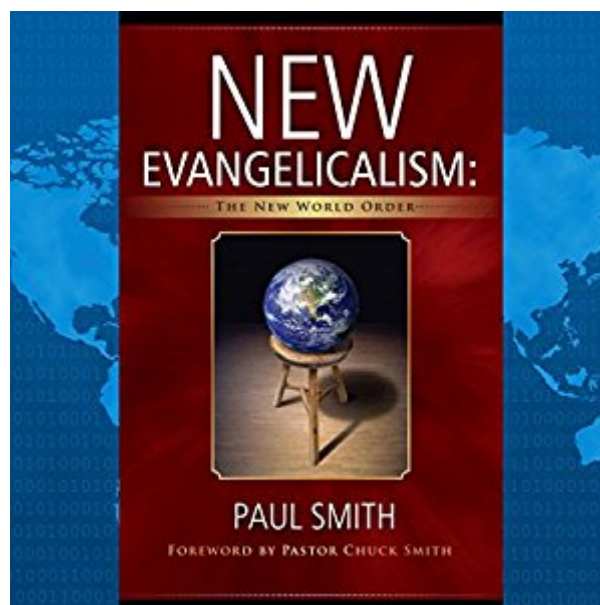


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New Evangelicalism: The New World Order: How The New World Order Is Taking Over Your Church (And Why Your Pastor Will Let Them Do It To You)

I was expecting more from this book when I bought it. For those who haven't yet purchased it, you need to know that most of the first half of the book is a very detailed account of the history of Fuller Theological Seminary. Obviously Mr. Smith has done his homework and has access to many of the letters and communications regarding those involved in leadership at Fuller. The second part of the book is primarily about the author's brother (Chuck Smith) and his battles at Calvary Chapel with the

Vineyard movement, the Emergent Church, Rick Warren, Bob Buford, Peter Drucker, etc. etc. For me, this book is more of a historical narrative of Fuller and Calvary Chapel and the changes and challenges they have gone through. Although I agree with the author's conclusions and the point he is making (we need to fight for the inerrancy of the Bible), I found myself getting bored reading about every little detail regarding letters, conversations, etc. etc. regarding Fuller and Calvary Chapel. I assumed wrongly that the book would have much more substance in terms of theology. This is my mistake though and not the authors. I would suggest the book be subtitled to let potential readers know the the book is primarily about Fuller Theological Seminary and Calvary Chapel. There are many Christians who aren't that familiar with either institution and will quickly just toss the book to the side. If you have an interest in the history of Fuller Theological Seminary and Calvary Chapel, then this book will be good of you. If, on the other hand you are looking for something that has wider appeal in teaching the dangers of the heresy that has crept into the church (e.g. the emergent church, etc.), then you would be better served looking for a book that speaks to broader range of an audience.

Gets into the nitty gritty politics of religion. Most Christian churches believe and have faith in an inerrant Bible. Clergy traditionally have read directly from the KJV Bible and are inspired to preach how scripture applies in contemporary life. However, the New Evangelicalism approaches the Bible from a distance. Emphasis on how to attract new comers to church is used by enticements to individual needs, rather than what the Bible says. This leads to collective salvation, or groupthink not based on fundamentals of the Bible, but man's testing of faith by adhering to groups cultural norms. Satan has gotten into US megachurches on a mega-scale. This book should be read by every member of the clergy and a lesson on fundamental Christianity's true purpose, not a Purpose Driven middle way leading to a 'social justice' church. It seems that a collectivist church wants to prevent sinning by holding parishioner's to standardized Cliff's Notes, rather than the Bible's admonishments. Do not fall prey to this new evangelicalist approach to faith. It requires more faith in man than in God and Jesus Christ our Savior. The Bible rules, guides and provides and we must continue to read it to be replenished by God's love, not man's errant rules.

I give this four stars for content, not necessarily continuity. If you are looking for sound explanations of how the New Evangelicals (literally liberal/progressive/emergent) have strayed from God's Word, this covers the topic both doctrinally and historically. The latter is my only reason for not giving this five stars. Smith deals in depth (for a book this size) with the demise of Fuller Seminary giving

names, programs, influences etc. While it is good to have this documented it was not why I was interested in the book. Some who have a better understanding of Fuller and its slide will find these chapters (4-5 of them) illuminating. For me they were difficult to get through. Although the information is important, it is only background for why I read the book and to me overly emphasized. That said I would recommend the book simply for topics covered on Bible inerrancy, doctrines and especially the parts about how New Evangelicals are in tandem with a New World Order. That alone is worth the read.

A little bit long in the beginning because of the immense detail and research that has gone into this book but really gets to pulling everything together towards the middle to the end.
