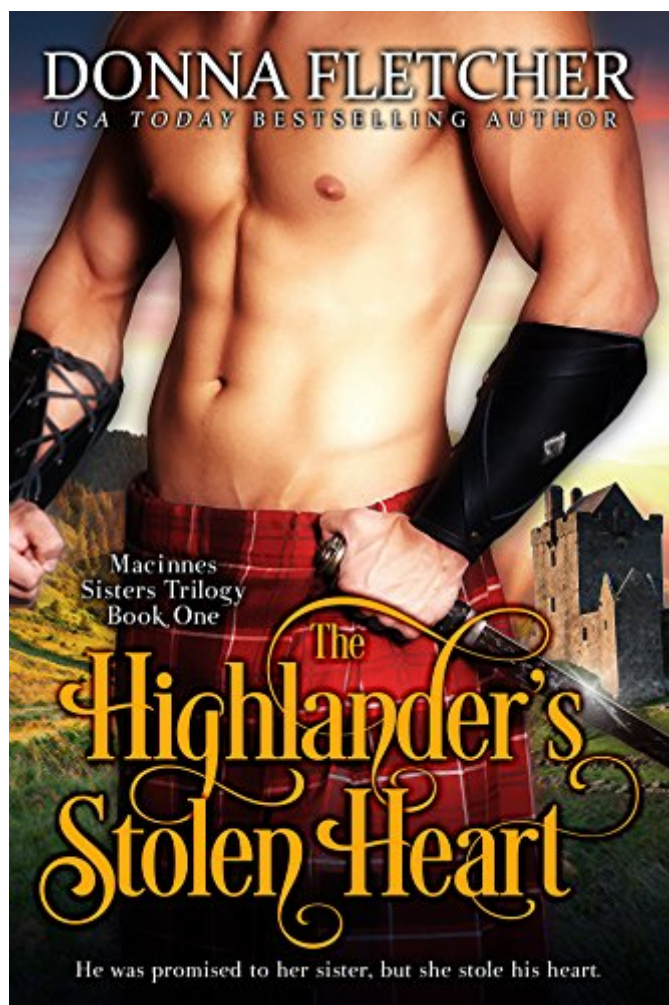

I liked the premise of the close bond these sisters have. I didn't feel that connected to these characters. Rogan fell for Emma far too quickly. He requested Heather to be his bride because she's the pretty one? Then within days of meeting plain Emma he's attracted to her. Emma was a willful I will never listen to you type. Rogan's suppose to be a great warrior, but Emma sneaks out of bed repeatedly and he's unaware she's gone? There was a lot more sex than substance to this one. It doesn't really end it leaves you waiting for book 2 which will leave you waiting for book 3. I don't like books like that.

Honestly two stars is being nice in my thoughts. While the author has written what could have been a fantastic story, she degraded it by not doing any research on the history of Scotland in 1432. Not just no history fact checking, but she also uses modern language. Was Mrs. Flether being lazy, or did she not care? Shoes: In 1432 Highlanders weren't wearing real shoes, boots, or sandals--SIDE NOTE: This right here is what really upset me. SANDALS?!?! In Scotland? Has she even visited Scotland in the winter?!?!---Highlanders normally wore a cow hide shoe. They would wrap the hide around their foot. Poke hole to "lace" it up and cut off the extra. They were then forced to poke holes in the bottom so the extra water would drain out. Fashion: While Mrs. Lazybu--- I mean Mrs. Flether didn't go into great detail about the clothes.
