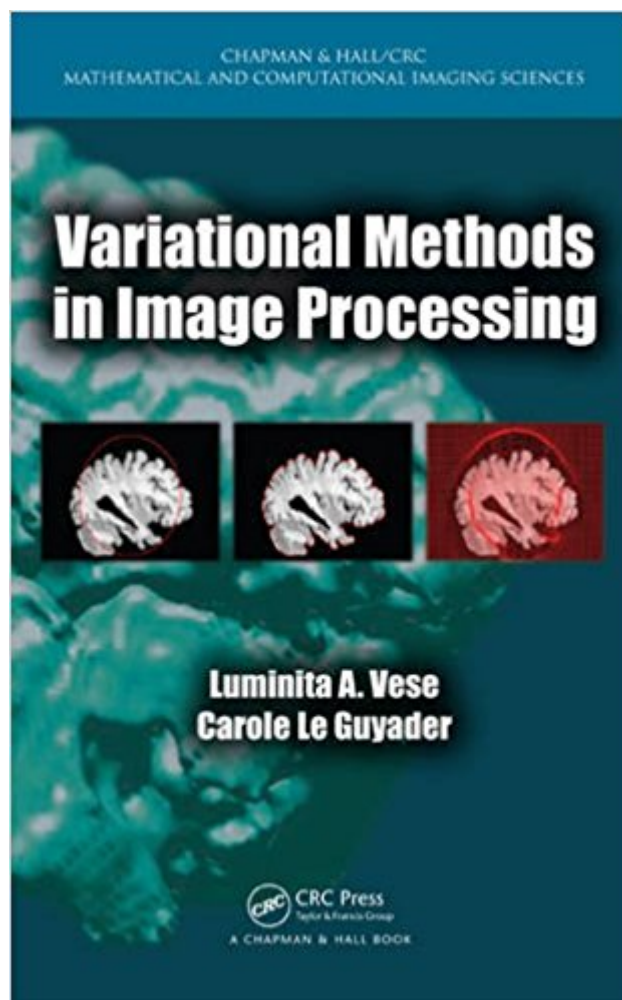




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Variational Methods In Image Processing (Chapman & Hall/CRC Mathematical And Computational Imaging Sciences Series)
