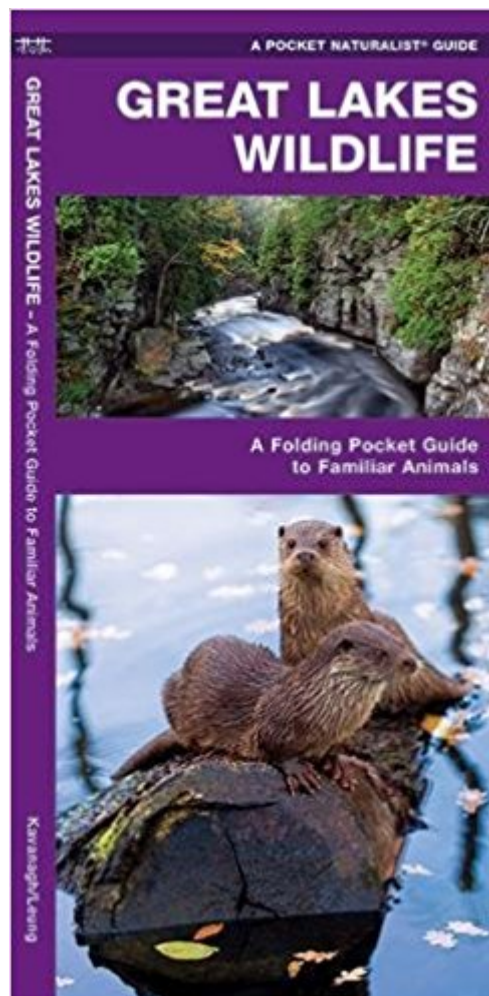

This is not a BOOK but a fold over, laminated pamphlet. Contains a page on invertebrates pictures, 2 pages on fishes, 1 page on reptiles and amphibians, 3 on birds and 3 on mammals. The scientific name and the size of the animal is all the information that is listed. I was expecting some description that would help distinguish an organism from other similar ones. I was surprised that neither the carp nor the alewife was included.
