It was Tuvalu's altitude - or rather its distinct lack of altitude - which first brought internationally-acclaimed photographer Peter Bennetts to this scattering of islands. Bennetts has a keen interest in environmental issues and there is no doubt that Tuvalu is on the climate-change front line. His regular visits to Tuvalu led to contact with Prime Minister Ionatana Ionatana. Together they came up with the idea of producing a book about Tuvalu, something which could help to focus

attention both on the island nation's story and its troubling challenges.

I have always been fascinated by faraway & isolated countries like Tuvalu, I have travelled a lot and i have been to the Pacific in two occasions and it is the area in the world that i like the most and this book definitely makes me enter the everyday life of this tiny in land size but beautiful country.
