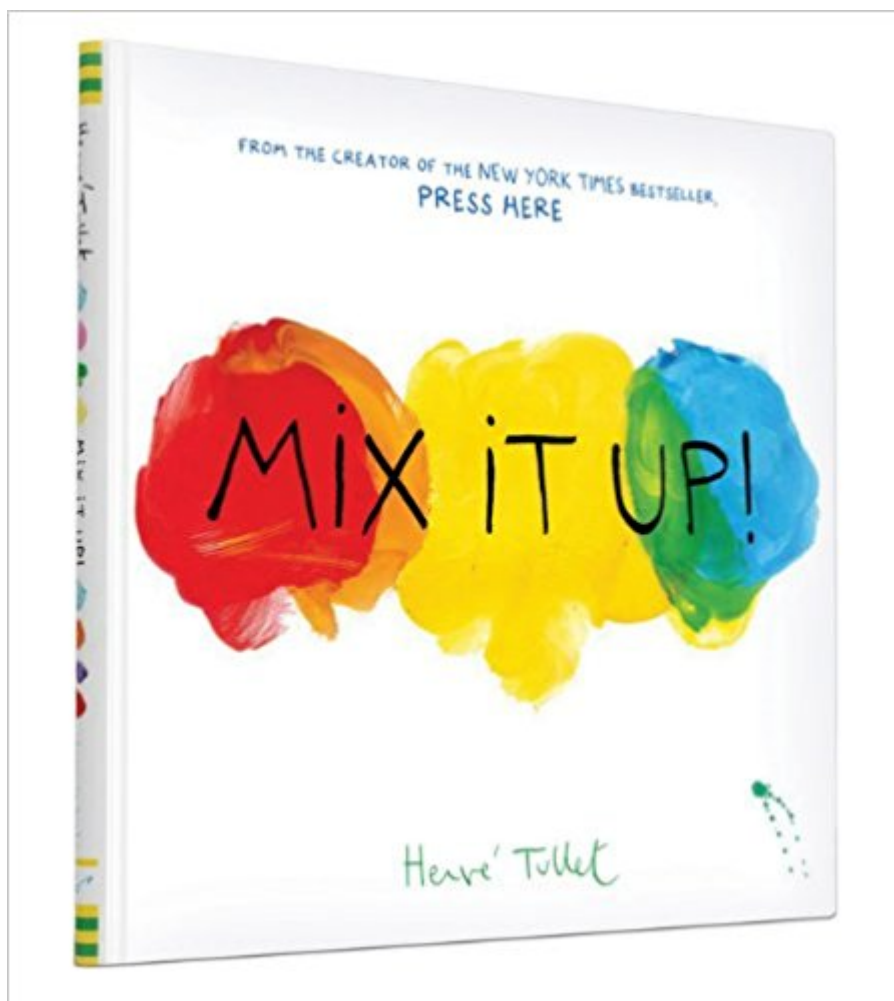

Hervé Tullet is known for his prodigious versatility, from directing ad campaigns to designing fabric for Hermès. But his real love is working with children, for whom he has published dozens of books, including Press Here. He lives in Paris, France.

The red, yellow and blue dots from Herve' Tullet's "Press Here" are at it again! In "Mix it Up!", a gray dot and multiple, different color smudges introduce your child to the interactive style Tullet uses to engage young listeners. Using gentle questions and simple "commands", Tullet draws the child into the book and gives that child a sense of control over the events taking place. Then the red, yellow, and blue dots take over. As the child follows the instructions, the dots combine to demonstrate the way the primary colors mix and form the secondary colors. Printed on glossy, heavy weight paper, the colors in "Mix it Up!" are vivid and clear. Heavy cardboard front and back covers make the book quite sturdy. I liked that "Mix it Up!" used few words, but conveyed complex information in a form a child could easily understand. Like Tullet's "Press Here", this sequel delighted my grandson and produced expressions of delight as we read and turned the pages to discover what he had done. While "Press Here" was geared toward younger children of 2-years old and older, "Mix it Up!" seems to appeal to children who are a bit older and ready to comprehend the complexities of color

creation. However, I would not hesitate to recommend this book for younger children. If you do not have "Press Here", I definitely recommend purchasing both books for your library or for that of a child you love.

I got this book for my niece on her third birthday. When i read it to her she giggled and squealed with delight!The book is interactive, giving you instructions like, "tap here" or "tilt the book to the right." Then, when you turn the page, the picture changes to reflect the instruction that was given.I will definitely get this for my other niece, along with his other books!

GREAT for teaching colors to kids who like to touch! I love Tullet's books and sent a pair to my godson for his first birthday after they went over so well with my own kids. My kids request this book almost nightly. They love touching the page, the magic of calling up the colors, the guesswork that goes into the gentle questions of "What happens next...?"

My kids absolutely LOVE this book! It is really engaging and makes them really think about colors and how they work together. A lot of time when we have reading time, they get distracted and their eyes and minds wander, but not with this book! Every page asks for interaction, and my kids have a lot of fun with it!

Herve Tullet is a genius! Simple but fun books that are interactive. I have given this and his other book "Press Here" as baby gifts for years. Everyone tells me that as the kids grow the book becomes more and more fun! I highly recommend both books. Buy them 5 or 10 at time like I do.
