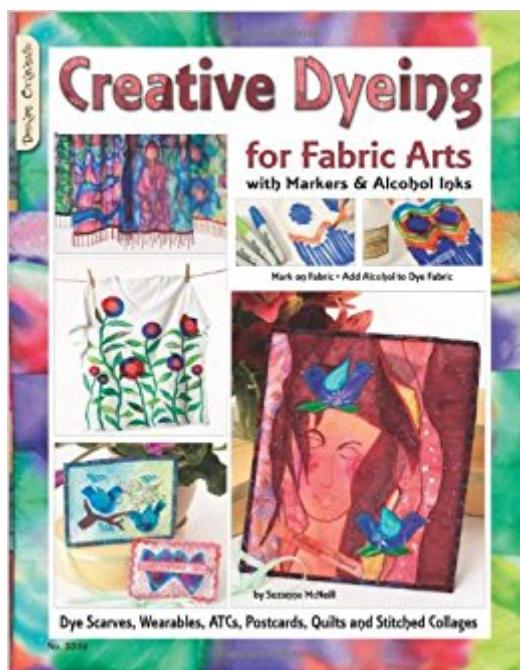

These projects can be done by anyone including children, who will love decorating their old t-shirts with sharpies. All the directions are in this book and you probably have everything at home right now.

The book is very interesting but I have not had time to experiment with it. However, there are a number of hints for dying fabric with easily accessible paints and dyes.
