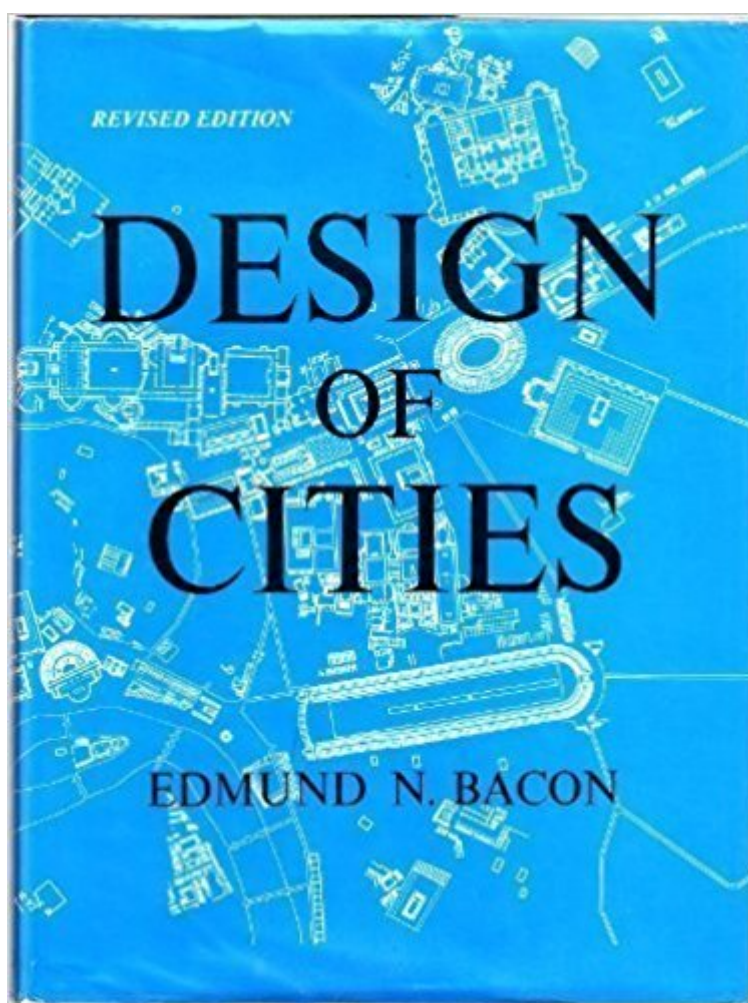


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Design Of Cities, Revised Edition (A Studio Book)

He also stresses the importance of designing open space as well as architectural mass and discusses the impact of space, color, and perspective on the city-dweller.
