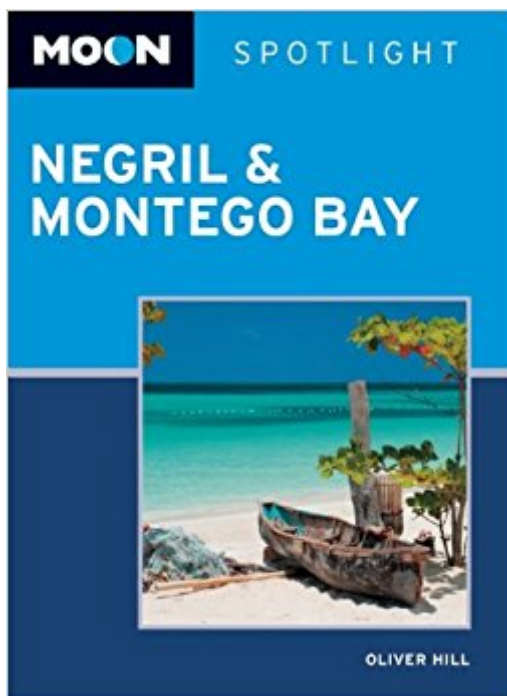


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Moon Spotlight Negril & Montego Bay

A dedicated reggae fan from a young age, Oliver Hill began his lasting relationship with Jamaica like many Americans, through the island's music. Friendships with fellow students of Jamaican heritage in high school ultimately led Oliver to visit the island, where he established a recording studio in a Kingston suburb in partnership with a local artist. Later a master's program in journalism at Columbia University took Oliver back to Jamaica with a film crew to shoot *Coping with Babylon*, a chronicle of contemporary Rastafarian philosophy. Oliver is a Spanish American journalist based in New York City. He has worked as a music video editor, ornithologist, and financial writer. He attended Northfield Mount Hermon School in Massachusetts before receiving a bachelor of science degree from Cornell University. Frequent trips to Spain and other destinations throughout his youth gave Oliver a global perspective on life and an unquenchable thirst for experiencing new places and cultures.

One of the most useful travel guides I've ever bought. Insight on everything including food and drinks! I bought at least half a dozen other guide books on Jamaica and this was the one I carried around. It was by far the best. Not nearly as much info on Montego Bay as Negril, but to be honest that seemed to be reflective of what was actually there. Wasn't really impressed with Montego Bay, and I stayed at The Ritz. Negril was a much better time. Maybe Montego Bay would've been better with a family or to relax, but Negril was a blast.

I found this to be one of the least useful travel books that I have purchased, but maybe someone who stayed in Negril instead of MoBay found it more useful. My wife and I stayed at Palmview Guesthouse located between the Hip Strip and the MoBay airport which we found using Tripadvisor and is not even listed in this book. I found it lacking in practical information concerning how to use local transportation (particularly the larger busses) or shop for food and also found most of the restaurant reviews useless. I felt as if I could have written a better guide myself for someone who decides to stay in MoBay and not in a nearby all-inclusive where everything is provided. However, I will admit that this includes an extremely small minority of travelers since we never saw more than a handful of tourists except during the day when a cruise ship was in town. In fact, we essentially had the guesthouse pool to ourselves the entire week, and this was in February.

Handy book.
