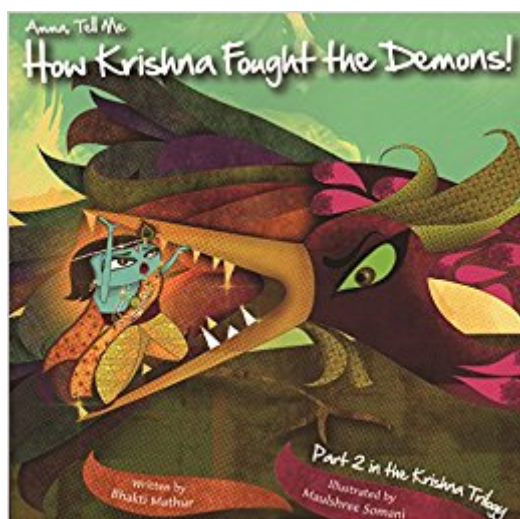

'Amma, Tell Me' series of books came as a way to introduce her sons to Indian mythology and festivals. When not writing, working or running after her boys, she is happiest curled up with a book and a hot cup of chai.

I am an elementary school teacher and a mom of two. This is the only Hindu picture book series I have found that is well-written, accurate, respectful, and beautifully illustrated. It is appealing to both toddlers and upper elementary kids. As a Hindu parent, I am happy to teach my daughters about their culture using these books. As a teacher, I know I can trust this author in my classroom to teach Hinduism in a respectful, knowledgeable way. Just a word of warning: I have seen another series out there with incredibly cute graphic illustrations (you may know which one I'm talking about, it's quite popular on ), and even though I LOVE the illustrations, I am so disappointed with the content--both inaccurate & disrespectful, probably because the author/illustrator is not a practicing Hindu, which I found out later. This Amma Tell Me About series is so much better for teaching kids. If you are deciding between the two, go with this one!

This series has very negative language. The author could've chosen different and age appropriate words to communicate the story and the message.
